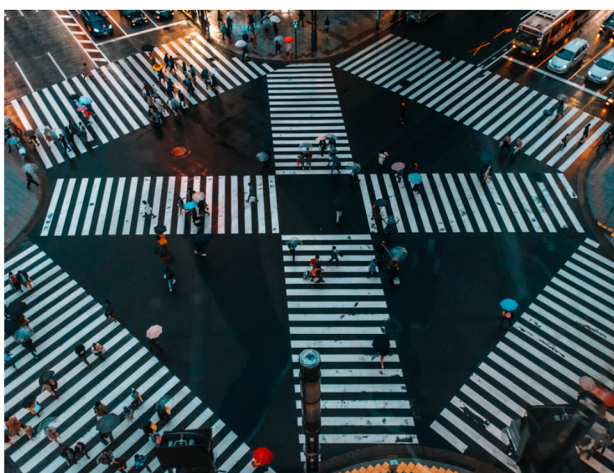

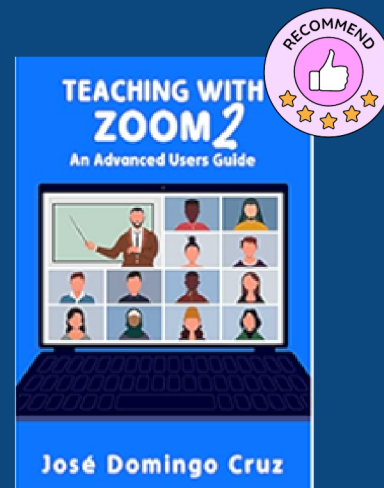

Why 'Teaching with Zoom 2' is the book every Zoom user needs



In early 2022, when I'd decided to organise my own private webinars, I purchased 'Teaching with Zoom 2' to level up my Zoom hosting skills. The webinars were going to be my very first time organising and advertising online meetings entirely on my own, and with close to 50 people indicating an interest in attending and the Zoom links being shared publicly online, I knew I needed to level up my skills.

Prior to purchasing the book, I'd attended a couple of José's impromptu Zoom meetings in the early stages of the pandemic. There, he would patiently walk me and the other educators through the features of the app and then have us take turns at the controls. His name very quickly became synonymous with high-level Zoom skills in TESOL circles in Japan, and I felt confident in his knowledge and expertise.

Admittedly, I was a little nervous about the 'Advanced Users Guide' part of the title, but the book turned out to be a pretty easy read. Although it is marketed to educators, it can be used by anyone looking to improve their Zoom skills, including beginners. José comes across as warmly on paper as he is in real life, and he masterfully walks the line between explaining the technology to a novice without sounding condescending and refreshing the memory of an expert without being boring.

Each section of the book is divided into easily digestible sub-sections, and the book is filled with illustrative screenshots and humorous anecdotes. José shares much of his own experiences learning and troubleshooting Zoom, and it was refreshing to see such an expert be candid about where his own knowledge and understanding of the software fell short. In addition to topics related to online teaching, he also covers security, choosing the right equipment, accessibility, and must-know Zoom features like breakout rooms, screen and audio sharing, and polls.



Despite having been published in 2021, much of 'Teaching with Zoom 2' is still applicable to Zoom use today. I bought it on paperback and loved how easily I could flip through its pages to find the information I wanted to review. This book is a must-read for anyone looking to bolster their Zoom skills.
